COMMUNITY RELATIONS COLLEGE & COMMUNITY GROUPS Use of Equipment Audiovisual #6121

POLICY

The College desires to cooperate with the community and will permit selected audiovisual-type equipment to be made available for use by groups in Ocean County at no charge, within the framework of the criteria listed below:

- 1. The instructional requirements of the college shall have priority on all equipment.
- 2. Arrangements for borrowing, including completion of college forms, shall be made through the Office of the Director of Academic Technology, one week in advance of borrowing date.
- 3. Equipment will be picked up and returned by the borrower at the convenience of the college.
- 4. Borrower must exhibit ability to operate the machinery.
- 5. Any damage to equipment must be borne by the borrower.
- 6. The borrowing group shall be nonprofit and noncommercial. Examples of eligible groups are: religious institutions, service clubs, educational groups, voluntary health agencies, and youth organizations.
- 7. The equipment shall not be used at any meeting, exhibition, gathering or demonstration at which admission is charged.
- 8. The function at which the equipment is to be used shall be open to the general public <u>or</u> membership in the group shall be open to the general public.
